Terms & Conditions

Before completing the application form, please ensure you read the following terms & conditions carefully.

Childhood First has a limited number of Golden Bond places. You can apply if you pledge to run the Virgin London Marathon 2011 and raise a minimum total of £1,500 for Childhood First by 30 May 2011. Your application will be subject to a selection process so that Childhood First can ensure that Golden Bond places are used to best-possible effect.

You agree to pay a £75 registration fee to Childhood First to secure your place no later than 14 days after it has been confirmed. Failure to do so will result in you losing your place unless you have agreed otherwise with Childhood First in advance.

If your application for a Golden Bond place is not successful, Childhood First regrets that due to administrative overheads we cannot always notify you in writing.

Payment deadline for sponsorship is 30 May 2011. If you need more time to collect sponsorship, please let Childhood First know in writing in advance of this date.

It is understood that if you fail to raise the minimum sponsorship detailed you will be required to submit the shortfall.

Monies reclaimed by Childhood First from the Inland Revenue for Gift Aid, (or any other charity tax scheme) do not count towards the total value of the sponsorship you raise.

If you cancel your Golden Bond place because you have gained your own place in the Virgin London Marathon Ballot, and you are still running to raise funds for Childhood First, please notify Childhood First by 29 October 2010 so that we are able to offer your Golden Bond to others.

If you decide not to run the Virgin London Marathon – or decide to run for another charity – please inform Childhood First before 29 October 2010. Your registration fee will be retained.

IMPORTANT: If you wish to withdraw for any reason after the official registration has closed, please contact Childhood First before the day of the run. It is important that you do not take part in the Marathon unless you are completely fit to do so. If you wish to defer your place to the following year please make Childhood First aware as soon as possible so that a decision can be made and a place reserved for you if necessary. However, you must agree to abide by all terms and conditions that Childhood First publishes for the subsequent event.

All Golden Bond holders agree that images taken on the day of the Marathon may be used by Childhood First to promote the London Marathon in the future.
